## Local High School Performers to be Recognized at the

## **Tommy Awards Show in Madison**

WAUSAU, WI – June 1, 2017 - Student performers from local theater organizations are being recognized for their talents at the Tommy Awards Show in Madison this weekend.

The Tommy Awards were created by the Overture Center in Madison to recognize and encourage outstanding high school musical theater across the state of Wisconsin. Educators and industry professionals review each of the productions and provide written feedback for the schools. In addition to writing critiques, Tommy Reviewers nominate productions for awards in a number of categories, including performance, direction and design.

The program originated eight years ago in Dane County, and has since grown to include 87 productions, including nine in the North Central region. This is the first year The Grand has been involved with the Tommy Awards, and Executive Director Sean Wright is excited to recognize the talent in the area. "We are absolutely thrilled to be a part of the Tommy Awards," he said. "Our first full year as a partner has seen amazing performances by students across our region, and we can't wait to see what 2017-18 has in store."

The Tommy Awards recognize high school theater productions for outstanding lead performances, supporting performances, youth performances, ensembles, orchestras, dance performances, direction, choreography, stage management, overall design, scenic design, costume design, lighting design, sound design, and the coveted Outstanding Musical award. One area production, Central Wisconsin Educational Theater Alliance's production of *Shrek the Musical* received an Award for Outstanding Musical.

Some of the students receiving Tommy Awards will be performing at the Tommy Awards Show, which will be held at the Overture Center in Madison on Sunday, June 11. The cast of CWETA's *Shrek the Musical*, will perform a number during the Awards Show, as well as the recipients of the Award for Outstanding Lead Performance, Supporting Performance, Dance Performance, Youth Performance, and the Spirit Award.
