WAUSAU, WI – June 6, 2018 – After a record-breaking season with 18 sold-out shows, recognition by Pollstar Magazine as one of the Top 150 Theaters in the World, the expansion of the Community Engagement Series, and performances from incredible artists of all kinds, The Grand Theater is proud to announce its 2018-19 Season. The 24 shows in the lineup have earned a combined 13 Grammy Awards, 6 Tony Awards, 86 Top Ten hits, 40 #1 hits, and almost 95 million tickets sold worldwide.

As always, The Grand is bringing world-class Broadway to Central Wisconsin, both heartwarming classics and Wausau premiers. THE ILLUSIONISTS – LIVE FROM BROADWAY – Tuesday, October 2
