# The Grand announces its 2024/25 Season!

WAUSAU, WI – June 3, 2024 – The Grand Theater is proud to present its newly announced 2024/25 Season, which features the biggest lineup of shows in recent history and its most acclaimed series of Broadway musicals. While The Grand has always brought nationally touring Broadway shows and large ensemble spectacles to Wausau, the upcoming 24/25 Season expands this tradition by offering two nights each of six major hit productions:

- The Tony Award-winning Best Musical **Dear Evan Hansen** (Dec. 9-10), declared "one of the most remarkable shows in musical theater history" by the Washington Post.
- The innovative, mythic musical **Hadestown** (Jan. 6-7), winner of eight 2019 Tony Awards including Best Musical and the 2020 Grammy Award for Best Musical Theater Album.
- Ain't Too Proud The Life and Times of The Temptations (April 15-16), the electrifying musical nominated for 12 Tony Awards in 2019 and winner of Best Choreography.
- Pretty Woman: The Musical (Feb. 13-14), called "irresistible" by The Hollywood Reporter, with an original score by Grammy winner Bryan Adams and Jim Vallance ("Summer of '69", "Heaven"), and a book by the movie's legendary director Garry Marshall and screenwriter J. F. Lawton.
- **Cirque Dreams Holidaze** (Dec. 18-19), returning to The Grand for the first time since 2019 with its dazzling and whimsical family spectacular wrapped in a Broadway-style production and contemporary circus arts.
- **Riverdance** (May 14-15), returning with its 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary tour that features new innovative choreography and costumes and state of the art lighting, projection and motion graphics.

In total, the 24/25 Season features 37 shows between September 2024 and late-May 2025. (The entire Grand Theater schedule also includes add-on shows, plus outside promoter and local production rental events). "The Grand is for everyone," says Executive Director Sean Wright, "and the 24/25 Season lineup truly embodies our on-going effort to offer a fantastic variety of performances and events that appeal to people of all ages and backgrounds."

Audiences will find, for example, incredible music from all genres. The Grand is especially proud to offer the rare opportunity to see one of the world's most renowned chamber orchestras, the London-based **Academy of St.**Martin in the Fields (March 1). Part of their limited U.S. spring tour, this concert features award-winning pianist Bruce Liu performing Mozart's Piano Concerto No. 9.

There's masterful jazz celebrating the New Orleans Songbook and Spirit of Mardi Gras by Jazz at Lincoln Center Presents (March 21). The legendary Ozark Mountain Daredevils (Sept. 13) performs for their farewell tour "When It Shines" in The Grand's season opener. Leonid & Friends (Oct. 1), the charismatic, jaw-dropping tribute to the band Chicago, makes an encore appearance after their highly acclaimed debut at The Grand last year. And Wausau will be treated to one of the major music influencers of our generation, Ben Folds (Oct. 8), when this famed pop music artist and composer takes the stage in Wausau for his Paper Airplane Request Tour.

Some of the most beloved and popular touring acts on the road today will also grace The Grand's stage this season, including "Funny Mother" comedian **Dena Blizzard** (Nov. 23); **Whose Live Anyway?** (Sept. 21) improv comedy show; country music star **Terri Clark** (Nov. 16); and the #1 Michael Jackson tribute show in the world, **Invincible** (May 3).

In addition to Cirque Dreams Holidaze, families will enjoy a wide range of other performances that captivate all ages, including **The Magic of Rob Lake** (Feb. 23), the dance and storytelling sensation **Step Afrika!** (April 22), the violin and DJ pop/reggae concert by **Sons of Mystro** (Oct. 29), and Wausau favorite **Yamato: Drummers of Japan** (March 7).

And there are plenty of performances audiences will love for sheer fun and the joy of popular music, such as: the return of Mania: The ABBA Tribute (Oct. 11); Celebrating Meat Loaf (Oct. 25) the only tribute officially endorsed by Meat Loaf himself and featuring a Halloween season bonus of songs from *The Rocky Horror Picture Show*; the rockin' bagpipe group Red Hot Chilli Pipers (March 28); and the new Dirty Dancing in Concert (Feb. 8) the beloved movie's first film-to-concert experience with a live band and dancers performing the soundtrack as the movie plays on a cinema-sized screen on stage!

#### Ozark Mountain Daredevils - September 13, 2024

#### Daniel O'Donnell – September 20

The Donegal-based singer is one of the most prolific and successful recording artists in the UK. He has been inducted into Ireland's Music Hall of Fame, and received multiple Entertainer of the Year/Person of the Year Awards in Ireland and the UK – to mention but a few of the many accolades earned by this charming, one-of-a-kind performer.

## Whose Live Anyway? - September 21

#### **Leonid & Friends** – October 1
