The Grand announces its fun-filled, fantastic 2025/26 Season!

WAUSAU, WI – June 2, 2025 – The Grand Theater's newly announced 2025/26 Season features the biggest lineup of shows in recent history, and brings stage and screen star Richard Thomas to Wausau as Mark Twain!

The Grand once again offers a series of acclaimed Broadway hits, which this season features two fun-filled shows the entire family can enjoy. These major, nationally touring productions in 2025/26 include:

- The devilishly delightful musical comedy **The Addams Family** (Oct. 14-15). Join everyone's favorite creepy, kooky characters as they meet the "normal" family of daughter Wednesday Addams' new boyfriend in this hilarious musical for all ages.

- See stage and screen star Richard Thomas in Mark Twain Tonight! (Feb. 17), the legendary, hilarious and wise
 one-man show originally performed and written by Hal Holbrook. Thomas is the first and only actor
 authorized to perform this play since the original, and Wausau is part of this revival's debut national tour!
 Millions of people know Thomas from his Emmy-winning role as John-Boy Walton and recently for his
 celebrated national stage roles in Our Town and To Kill a Mockingbird.
- **Chicago** (March 3-4) returns to The Grand with all the razzle dazzle and showstopping songs that made it Broadway's longest running musical and winner of six Tony Awards.

"We are thrilled to offer local audiences world-class theater experiences that are rare to find in cities the size of Wausau," says Executive Director Sean Wright. "The Grand's ability to schedule so many high caliber productions is a testament to north central Wisconsin's support of the performing arts."

In total, the 25/26 Season features 39 shows between August 2025 and May 2026. (The entire Grand Theater schedule also includes add-on shows, plus outside promoter and local production rental events).

Audiences also will find incredible music from all genres. **The Oak Ridge Boys** (Dec. 11) come to The Grand for their America Made Christmas Farewell Tour. New country hits the stage with **Six One Five Collective** (Nov. 14). You'll see legendary performers such as **The Righteous Brothers** (Aug. 21) in their farewell tour, and experience the iconic voice of folk music legend **Judy Collins** (Feb. 24).

In addition to *The Addams Family* and *Mrs. Doubtfire*, families will enjoy a wide range of other performances that captivate all ages, such as the return of **iLuminate** (Oct. 18), the heart-pounding **Drum Tao** (March 15), and the thrilling **360 Allstars** (April 22), the international smash hit that combines BMX, breakdancing, acrobats and music.

There are plenty of performances for the sheer joy of popular music. **Mania: The ABBA Tribute** (Oct. 21) returns for another disco party concert. Also returning by popular demand is **Celebrating Meat Loaf** (Oct. 24), the only tribute officially endorsed by Meat Loaf himself and featuring a Halloween season bonus of songs from *The Rocky Horror Picture Show!* There's even 90s grunge to love, as the popular Classic Albums Live company performs their exciting new **Lithium Experience** show (Jan. 24), which pays homage to the killer alternative hits by Pearl Jam, Nirvana, Alanis Morrisette, Stone Temple Pilots and more.

And perhaps in a category of its own, **The Folsom Prison Experience** (Oct. 3) combines stage drama with live music and audience interaction – as the inmates! – to recreate Johnny Cash's famous 1968 concert. Starring Jay Ernest from the Church of Cash, *The Folsom Prison Experience* is not just a performance; it's a full-throttled fun journey back in time to that legendary moment in music history.
